## Competition Rules

All competitions are organised in accordance with the "Competition Rules for IOF Foot Orienteering Events" valid from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2007, as modified in August 2008.

## Clothing

All competitors shall wear clothes covering all parts of the body, except arms and head, during the middle and long distance competitions and the relay. The clothing in the sprint competition is free.

## Punching System

The SportIdent punching system will be used. All competitors must use the SI card issued by the Organisers. Cards will be issued at Registration. Team Leaders are responsible for returning all SI cards after the Relay.

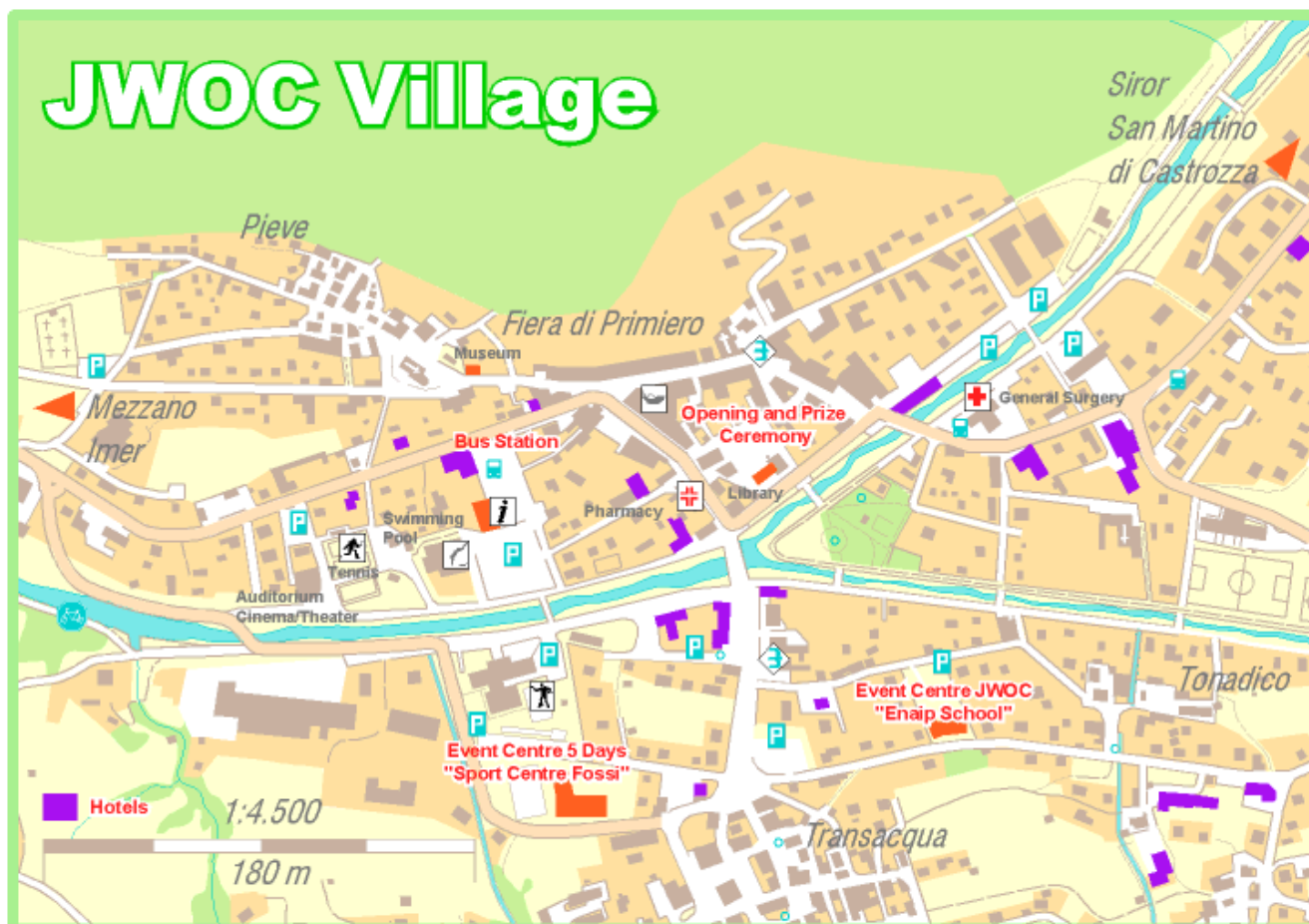
## Event Transportation

Transport to and from all events will be provided for all competitors and officials and is included in the entry fee. All buses will depart from and return to the bus station in Fiera di Primiero.

All competitors and officials must use the official transport to the start area. Individual transport to the Event Arena can be used (no discount on entry fee).

## JWOC Event Centre

The JWOC Event Centre and Competition Office will be at the ENAIP School



**Maps**

Maps conform to the IOF standards ISOM 2000 and ISSOM 2007. They are based on LIDAR laser survey information.

**Team Leaders' Meetings**

Team Leaders' meetings will be held in the JWOC Event Centre on the day before each competition.

**Ceremonies**

The Opening Ceremony, Prize Giving Ceremonies and Closing Ceremony will take place in the Municipio Square in Fiera di Primiero. There will be entertainment provided before the Ceremonies, including screens showing TV film from the races. Flower ceremonies will be held in the Event Arena immediately after the races are finished.

**Embargoed Areas**

Entering embargoed areas is forbidden, except for the main roads passing through them.

It is forbidden to walk in or visit the villages of the sprint distance area (Mezzano-Imer); the only exceptions are the main road and the route to the Football Stadium in Mezzano.

## Terrain Description

### **Long – Passo Rolle 1:15.000** (5m contour interval)

(1400m-2000m above sea level) The long distance race will be held at Passo Rolle. The area is about 20 km from the Event Centre. Mainly coniferous woods with good visibility. Plenty of rock and contour details. Mixed runnability from good to very slow (due to undergrowth and rocky terrain). The Event Arena is in open meadows near the top of the Passo.

### **Middle – San Martino 1:10.000** (5m contour interval)

(1400m-1600m above sea level) The middle distance races will held in S. Martino di Castrozza. The area is about 11 km from the Event Centre. Mainly coniferous woods with visibility from good to poor. Plenty of rock and contour details. Mixed runnability from good to slow (due to undergrowth and rocky terrain). The Event Arena is at the Sporting Hall of San Martino di Castrozza.



### **Relay – Val Canali 1:10.000** (5m contour interval)

(1000m-1300m above sea level) The relay will be held in the Val Canali valley. The area is about 7 km from the Event Centre. Mixed coniferous woods with varied visibility, and areas of open meadow with scattered woodland. Plenty of rock and contour details. Mixed runnability from fast to slow. The Event Arena is in the field around Villa Welspergh.

### **Sprint – Mezzano-Imer 1:4.000** (2,5m contour interval)

(650m-700m above sea level) The sprint race will be held in the towns of Mezzano and Imér. The area is about 4 km from the Event Centre. Two urban areas with many old buildings and narrow passageways, surrounded by fields. Many man-made features and little contour detail. Very good to excellent runnability. The Event Arena is in the Football Stadium in Mezzano.

### **Dolomites 5-Day Event**

The Dolomites 5-Day Event is taking place in parallel with JWOC and has attracted well over 3000 entries from around the world. The 5-Day Event Centre is located at the Sports Centre Fossi in Fiera di Primiero.

### **Local Weather Conditions**

The weather in Primiero in July is typically warm and pleasant (in the 20s ° C). It will be significantly cooler at higher altitude. There is also a chance of rain and thunderstorms. Details can be found on the website at [www.meteotrentino.it](http://www.meteotrentino.it).

### **Press and Media Representatives**

Press, media and extra representatives will be accommodated in hotels near the JWOC Event Centre. The Press Centre will be at the Tourist Information Office in Fiera di Primiero. Registration details are on the website.

Final registration should be received by June 1st. The fee should be paid by the 1<sup>st</sup> of June to the account given under Payments.

## Training Opportunities and Training Maps

The second official training period will be offered in the week before JWOC. A complete package including accommodation, meals and training maps with control posts will be offered.
